AXIS OF EVIL MAPPING NEWSLETTER #11 OF 2023 – Early December

INTRODUCTION

This will be the last Axis newsletter for 2023. Lan and I will be in the South Pacific/Australasia updating our mapping data until early January. Some maps may possibly arrive in our warehouse during December and these will be noted in our first newsletter of 2024. As we approach the end of 2023, the world is beset by raging wars in Ukraine, Israel, and Sudan, with nasty confrontations still besetting Ethiopia/Eritrea, Syria, Myanmar, and Yemen. Somalia is suffering from its worst floods in a century. South African society is rapidly collapsing, with daily electricity blackouts occurring more and more frequently. Coups have disrupted several countries in sub-Saharan Africa. Venezuela is a failed state, as is Zimbabwe and half a dozen other states. Irrational violence seems ever more common in the USA, unfortunately. One always hopes for peace, stability, and good will to prevail in 2024, but one's optimism is strained by the reality facing us as we enter a new year. On the positive side, travel shows continuing strong signs of improvement, albeit to only selected parts of the world, and those countries welcoming visitors will prosper during 2024.

We at ITMB thank you for your continued support of our efforts to map the world, one little bit at a time. We have now been doing so now for more than 43 years and could not have accomplished publishing over 600 maps over the past four decades of cities, countries, regions, and continents all over the world without the strong support of retailers, distributors, and individuals around the globe. During 2023, we introduced 55 new titles and editions and hope to exceed this figure in 2024. This is still a marvellous world, full of exciting places to visit, so from all of us at ITMB, thank you, have a Merry Christmas/Hannukah/Diwali and wait for some exciting new maps arriving in the months to come! Never give up hope.

NEW TITLES

One of the realities of recovering from the Covid era is that events sometimes unfold at a faster pace than we can record new developments. This happened to us, in that a couple of newly-arrived maps slipped past us and entered circulation without having a press release or being mentioned in an Axis newsletter. Thus, you may already have some of our New Releases for December already in your system, but if not, please note them. Easter Island is one of those exotic 'bucket-list' destinations still on my Places To Visit Before I Die list. This is the only map of the island that is available, and although not very much changes there, updates are periodically needed. This was completed early in 2020, but as we all know, Covid was creating chaos then and we sent the artwork to press, then forgot about it as we coped with a growing health problem, like everyone else. Eventually, the printed map arrived back in 2022 along with half a dozen others and we forgot to notify our clientele. Sorry about that; not usual for us, but the map has been selling steadily so I guess this only matters to those of you who flag out-of-print titles. If so, please re-instate Easter Island. Mexico Pacific Coast was prepared as part of Lan's drive to map the entire Pacific Coast of both North and South America in detail. We are pleased to announce its release, completing the project. We have new editions of Osaka and Philippines, and a new rendition of Sudan, showing South Sudan finally. Zambia has been a steady-selling Africa title for years. Nothing much changes there, but we eventually ran out of copies and are pleased to advise you of the release of an updated edition.

NEW ITMB TITLES COMING IN 2024

One of the side swipes of the Covid era is that we all hunkered down and hibernated for three years. However, printed travel guides and maps continued to age, even though nothing was changing. Travel guides in particular became very dated. Many hotels and restaurants shut down permanently or were sold and rebranded, making many guides obsolete. Also, publishers could not send out researchers to prepare new guides and were forced to discard guides that were considered to be unacceptably out-of-date. This helps to explain the paucity of post-Covid travel guides during 2023. Updated guides are gradually being released by such firms as Lonely Planet, Michelin, Bradt, and Rick Steeves, and there should be a more robust release of new guides throughout 2024. The same situation applies to the map industry. Michelin has done a marvellous job updating and releasing many map titles. ITMB is hoping to increase the pace at which older map editions are replaced during 2024; in fact, this is already evident in our New Releases segment and will become more noticeable as 2024 advances. We are also still working on some exciting brand-new titles, such as the Appalachian Hiking Trail and Hadrian's Wall, so 2024 looks like an exciting year for new releases from ITMB!

NELLES VERLAG IS NO MORE

One of the first companies to produce travel maps has called it a day. A press release I recently received notes: "the Austrian firm of Freytag & Berndt announces the takeover of the publishing business of Nelles Verlag. FB is now also taking over ...stock, artwork, trademark rights". Nelles, founded by Gunther Nelles in 1983, published the first authentic travel map (Bali) in that year, operating as an adjunct to APA Publishing of Singapore. This set a new industry in operation and led to a huge upsurge in travel to exotic destinations. Nelles became a major force in travel guide publishing (in German only) in the 1990s and published an excellent series of dozens of travel maps under the Nelles brand name. ITMB has been their North American distributor since 1985.

However, in recent years the firm has struggled. Gunther retired and his son Martin took over, assisted by his wife Agnes and an excellent aide, Susanne Hengl. Covid resulted in a dramatic loss of sales and revenue, forcing Susanne to leave the firm. An increasing number of map titles disappeared from their list, reducing their market penetration. I can't speak for the guide book side of the business as I have never been interested in it, but it was significantly large. The firm stopped attending trade shows and releasing lists of new titles and editions. Not a word was said by Freytag about this purchase of assets during the recent Frankfurt Book Fair but, as the press release from FB notes, "the operational business of Nelles Verlag in Munich will be discontinued as of October 31, 2023". Apparently, a truck arrived and moved all inventory to Austria, where it is now available to customers. We received notification of this change of ownership by email on November 9th.

What does this mean for the map trade? In the short term, nothing changes, except that inventory needs to be ordered from Vienna instead of Munich. What does FB intend to do with Nelles at a time when all map publishers are struggling to survive? That is a good question for which I do not have a good answer. The press release from FB states "with its up-to-date program and its close co-operation with many tour operators, Nelles has a good position in the market". Accepting this statement at face value, one has to ask how a new owner is going to win the trust of customers who were loyal to Gunther and his aims, but this is for FB to figure out. I have seen many such takeovers during my 44 years in the trade and few of them work out well for the name being taken over. I recall Batholomew being taken over by Harper Collins and disappearing, Haupka being taken over by Mairs and disappearing, Cartographia being swallowed up by a digital firm, PPWK disappearing, De Rourk disappearing, Estate disappearing, AMC disappearing, and a host of other mapping firms gone that remain only as nostalgic memories. Speaking as someone who has been representing Nelles for decades, I mourn the demise of an excellent publishing house and wish FB well with their new venture. I hope it prospers.

DECEMBER SHIPPING DIFFICULTIES

Due to what normally happens in December, commercial shipments often get delayed by shipping firms in order to concentrate on Christmas greeting cards and parcels going to individuals. We try and send out any received order within two working days, but we have no control over Canada Post, USPS, Fedex, DHL, or UPS. Everyone will do their best to get deliveries made in the shortest possible time, but December always sees a huge increase in things being sent, so please place orders early to guarantee delivery prior to Christmas. You may also ask for shipments to be delayed until January 1st. ITMB will be open weekdays throughout the month, but closed on Christmas Day and New Year's Day. Picture Lan and myself waving to you regally from the South Pacific!

British Columbia, another very popular title, is close to running out of inventory. A fresh edition is being prepared and is due in May, 2024.

California is unexpectedly out of print due to demand. An updated version is at press. No ETA.

Cuzco and Region is approaching the end of its print run. A new edition is being prepared.

Dominica/St. Lucia is getting low on inventory. New editions are being prepared; no ETA.

Germany is now out of stock. An updated edition has been sent to press. Due in late May.

Krakow is now out of print. A new double-sided map is being prepared. No ETA.

Mexico City is close to running out of copies. A fresh edition has been sent to press and is expected in May, 2024.

Northwest Territories is now out of print. We are preparing a new map that will combine it with Nunavut. **Nunavut** is also getting low on inventory, but is not in any danger of running out of copies at the moment.

Orlando/Central Florida is in danger of running out of copies, due to a sudden surge in demand that was unexpected. A new edition is being prepared, but has not yet reached the stage of being sent to press.

Toronto and Region suddenly and unexpectedly surged in demand during August and as a result is now out of print. A new edition has been sent to press; due in March.

USA East Part Map is now out of copies. A new version is being prepared. No ETA.

NEW RELEASES DURING NOVEMBER AND EARLY DECEMBER, 2023

Easter Island & Santiago Travel Reference Map 6th Ed. 2020 1:24,200/1:12,500 ISBN 9781771292696 UPC 817712926968 \$13.95cdn/us E/GBP 9.95 – This edition of Easter Island is another example of the disruption caused by the Covid epidemic. It was sent to press at a time when everyone thought Covid would be a six-week wonder. Our printer was locked down by the time this artwork reached him, which we only discovered six months later when we queried why we hadn't received the printed maps. Another six months passed before ships were able to dock in Vancouver, and a further three months delay occurred awaiting Customs clearance, due to lack of staff. The map was released early in 2023, and we are finally catching up on the backlog of things needing to be done, so we're pleased to announce that this new edition of Easter Island is in our warehouse. Whoopie! Being isolated Easter Island, one has to say that nothing much changes, but there is a nice new north-south road across the island, making it easier to reach some of the Moai (stone head statues) on the north shore and this joins the east-west road enabling a visitor to see the moai on the south shore. There are still a number of Moai on the northwest shore that can only be reached via a footpath, which is shown on the map. All the Moai are properly noted on the map. The main and only town of Hanga Roa is also shown on the map. The reverse side of the sheet is a detailed city map of Santiago de Chile. Our rationale is that all flights to Easter Island originate in Santiago and 99.9% of all persons going to or from Easter Island have to spend time in Santiago, so a good map of the city is a bonus. A basic inset map of central Chile is also included on side 2. **AVAILABLE**

Mexico Pacific Coast Travel Reference Map 1st Ed. 2023 1:1,500,000 ISBN 9781771294805 UPC 817712948052 \$13.95cdn/us E/GBP 9.95 – Last month, we noted a new map of the Pacific Coast of British Columbia and the Alaska Panhandle. This month, we introduce another brand new map, this one covering the west coast of Mexico from the American border at Tijuana all the way to Hidalgo on the Guatemalan border. By the shape of Mexico, this means that side 1 is vertical and provides excellent coverage of Baja California and the coast as far as Mazatlán. Side 2 is horizontal and continues south past Puerto Vallarta and Acapulco eastward to Hidalgo. Again, due to the shape of Mexico, this side includes a very large portion of central Mexico, including the Caribbean coast from Tampico to the Isthmus. An inset of central Mexico City, the largest city in North America, is also included. This map can be used with our well-established ITM map of Central America to cover the rest of the Pacific coastline all the way to South America. This has been a massive cartographic endeavour that has, as far as I know, never been done up until now. **AVAILABLE**

Osaka and Western Japan Travel Reference Map 3rd Ed. 2024 1:12,500/1:600,000 ISBN 9871771295956 UPC 817712959560 \$13.95cdn/us E/GBP 9.95 – This one of those maps that we love to do. Osaka is one of Japan's liveliest cities, deeply steeped in history, but very modern and vibrantly alive at the same time. Japan is emerging from the Covid era as a prime travel destination. Side 1 depicts the city from north of the main train station to south of the Tennoji Rail Station and includes Osaka Castle and includes two inset maps: one of the Kobe/Osaka urban region and another of central Kobe. Side 2 is a detailed map of western central Japan from west of Hiroshima to east of Nagoya, showing all the rail lines, motorways, and touristic attractions in this part of Japan. It also includes an inset map of the Kyoto/Nara region, so this map is very useful. **AVAILABLE**

Philippines Travel Reference Map 6th Ed. 2023 1:1,100,000 on waterproof paper ISBN 9871771296298 UPC 817712962980 \$14.95cdn/us E/GBP 10.90 – Post-Covid era travel to the Philippines is exploding in popularity! This newly updated map covers the entire country of 7,000+ islands. Side 1 covers the northerly Luzon Island region with an excellent inset of Manila at 1:12,000 scale. Side 2 concentrates on the more southerly Mindanao portion of the country, with insets of central Davao City and Cebu City. As Philippines is a rather humid country, the map is printed on waterproof stone paper for durability. The map is also covered with dozens of capsule comments, pointing out important features of Philippine history and culture. **AVAILABLE**

Sudan and South Sudan Travel Reference Map 4th Ed. 2024 1:2,000,000 ISBN 9781771297301 UPC 817712973016 \$14.95cdn/us E/GBP 10.90 - Considering that Sudan is locked into an even more brutal civil war than the one besetting Israel-Hamas, this might seem like an odd time to bring out our first-ever map of Sudan and South Sudan, but it may be an important area of the world to have an updated map of, to focus on a tragedy unfolding mostly unnoticed by the world at large. More than 10,000 locals have been slaughtered since a rebel group made an abortive grasp to overthrow the current government a couple of months ago, mostly in the Darfur region. ITMB publishes maps to encourage touristic travel, but our maps also bear witness to atrocities and natural disasters and are widely used by selected governments and humanitarian aid groups thanks to the accuracy of our artwork. Side 1 concentrates on Sudan from its disputed (and closed) border with Egypt south to a little below Khartoum, the capital. An inset map of central Khartoum is also included. Side 2 focusses on South Sudan from its borders with CAR, Congo, Uganda, and Kenya north to the still-contested border with Sudan and the southern provinces of that country. The most dominant feature of both Sudans is the Nile River (White Branch) that flows through both countries on its way to the Mediterranean. This is the first time that South Sudan has been so intensely mapped and is a credit to Lan's team of cartographers to portray a country carved recently out of adversity and coping with intense tribal rivalries. It is not practical for most of us to travel to either Sudan at the moment, but wars end, governments stabilize, and peace eventually reigns in every warring part of the world, and Sudan has an enormously important historical significance that will attract visitors in the future. For now, like our maps of Ukraine and of Palestine, it will probably sell well for what I would consider to be the wrong reasons, but this is an important map for the world to have at this particular point in time, so I urge everyone to stock it and all of you to open it and study it. There are several wars besetting our planet at the moment and nice though it may be to map pleasant travel destinations, ITMB has a long history of mapping countries suffering from war, famine, and natural disasters. Someone has to do it; it's important. **AVAILABLE**

Zambia and Eastern Africa Travel Reference Map 5th Ed. 2020 1:1,680,000 ISBN 9781771299213 UPC 817712992130 \$13.95cdn/us E/GBP 9.95 – This title has actually been available for many months. We had sent it to press in 2020, not realizing that the whole world had shut down while trying to overcome Covid, and it languished in the printer's premises for many months because they were shut down as part of the madness we all went through during the Covid era. It eventually arrived at our warehouse and we started marketing it – but forgot to send out a press release! Better late than never, I suppose, so consider it lately launched. Zambia, a nice country in central/southern Africa graces one side of the sheet, along with a very large inset map of Lusaka and two others of Livingstone and Victoria Falls (which is actually in Zimbabwe). The other side of the sheet contains a very useful regional map of eastern Africa from Ethiopia/Eritrea south to Eswatini/Swaziland. Madagascar is also included, as well as the Comoro Islands. While both sides are useful, it is the Zambian side that takes precedence. All the roads and towns are shown, as well as parks, safari lodges, and points of interest. It is possible, though not advisable, to travel to Zimbabwe via either Kariba or Vic Falls, and there is a good crossing into Botswana at Sesheke. Entry to and from Tanzania and Malawi is easy. **AVAILABLE**

NEW RELEASES DURING OCTOBER, 2023

BC Coast & Alaska Inside Passage Travel Reference Map (NEW TITLE!) 1st Ed. 2023 1:900,000 ISBN 9781771291095 UPC 817712910950 \$13.95cdn/us E/GBP9.95 – This is a new map for us, combining both the Canadian and the American portions of the Pacific coastline north from the Seattle area to the Alaska Panhandle, ending at the Glacier Bay National Park, which extends considerably north of the Bay itself. Side one concentrates on the Canadian portion, from Victoria north to the Queen Charlotte/Haida Gwaii islands, showing ferry routes and the routes most favoured by cruise ships. As a coastal map, it doesn't go very far inland, but shows the Coastal mountain range to good advantage. Side two provides a very detailed map of that portion of Alaska known as the Panhandle – a series of islands north and west of Canada that is very popular with cruisers. All parks and cruise line routes are shown. Interestingly, at the top end of Glacier Bay, the Canadian border splits the Panhandle from the rest of Alaska; not intentionally, but when the border was agreed upon in the early 1900s, no one realized that the glacier on that site might one day melt. Well, melt it has, leaving a kilometer-long stretch of beach that is part of Canada! Regardless, this map completes ITMB's mapping of the Pacific coastline of North America from the Bering Sea to Panama, a cartographic task that began decades ago. **AVAILABLE**

BC Southern & Alberta Southern Travel Reference Map 2nd Ed. 2023 1:900,000 ISBN 9781771297395 UPC 817712972958 \$13.95cdn/us E/GBP 9.95 – Canada is a huge geographic entity, even once split into provincial entities. Most of the touristic interest in both British Columbia and in Alberta is concentrated in the southern half of both provinces, so we try to make life easier for travellers visiting this part of the world to have a detailed map at a good scale showing the roads and attractions of one of the continent's most-visited touristic destination. Side 1 concentrates on BC from the American border north to Quesnel and showing all three passes through the Rocky Mountains. Side 2 does the same for Alberta as far north as Edmonton and includes both Banff and Jasper national parks. Detailed inset maps of Calgary and Edmonton are included. This map is ideal for the visitor needing a map of the Rockies that includes all the passes and parks in the region, while also showing the cities and road/rail infrastructure. Naturally, wilderness campsites are included. ITMB also publishes separate maps of each province. **AVAILABLE**

Greece Travel Reference Map 2nd Ed. 2023 1:625,000 on waterproof paper ISBN 9781771293235 UPC 817712932358 \$14.95cdn/us E/GBP 10.90 – Greece is one of the most important touristic destinations in the world. We have travelled the country extensively and have undertaken a serious upgrading of information for this edition. As a country, Greece divides naturally into three portions – the area around Athens and the Peloponnese, the far north region centred on Thessalonica, and the marvellous islands scattered around the southern portion of Greece. This is an overall map, showing the latest road information and noting historic and cultural sites of interest to visitors, including world heritage sites. An inset map of Athens is included, but ITMB's map of the city would be useful for those exploring Athens in detail. We also publish an expanded map of the Peloponnese, and another of Crete and Mykonos. **AVAILABLE**

Sicily & Southern Italy Travel Reference map 1:500,000 on waterproof paper 1:500,000 ISBN 9781771297653 UPC 817712976536 \$14.95 cdn/us E/GBP 10.90 – Although this is a title that ITMB has marketed for several years, it should count as a brand new map in that the artwork is now our own and the map includes a second side focused on southern Italy. The Sicily side concentrates on the infrastructure and touristic sites of the island itself, along with the southern tip of the Italian mainland, showing ferry crossings. Sicily has a rich history, with Greek and well as Roman remains to explore and Mount Etna to visit if it isn't erupting. The Valley of the Temples, south of Agrigento, is particularly worth seeing. The second side concentrates on that portion of Italy from Pescara in the far north to Naples, the Amalfi Coast, to Potenza all the way to Brindisi and Taranto (the 'heel' of the boot). The 'toe' of the boot is on side 1. The focus of this map is on Sicily, but as most access to the island is via the mainland, we think combining the two meets most visitors' needs. **AVAILABLE**

Athens and Peloponnese Travel Reference Map 1:8,000/1:625,000 2nd Ed. 2023 (1st for the Peloponnese side) ISBN 9781771290302 UPC 817712903020 on waterproof paper \$13.95cdn/us E/GBP9.95 – Athens is one of the most ancient and historic cities in the world. The Acropolis is the mountain upon which rests the Temple Athena, often called the Parthenon as it dominates the terrain. Close by is the Agora, the ancient city market centre, and at the foot of the Acropolis are two open-air theatres that date back to ancient times. Athens is also a modern city with congested roads, vibrant stores, and an excellent underground transit system. Included with Side 1 is a map of Piraeus, the nearby port city, with its many terminals for ferries leading to the various Greek islands. It is also one of the most active cruise ship terminals in the world, operating from Terminals A through C. A regional transit map is also included. Side 2 concentrates on the peninsula (technically an island) west of Athens called the Peloponnese that is the home to Olympus, Sparta, and other former city states of legendary fame. **AVAILABLE**

Canada East Coast Travel Reference Map 2nd Ed. 2024 1:535,000/1:150,000 ISBN 9781771290326 UPC 8117712903264 \$14.95cdn/us E/GBP10.90 – Canada is a vast country in area; inconceivably enormous in European terms. It is best mapped as a series of regional maps and this is the first of two maps that we hope will portray the Atlantic coastline of all of North America. Side 1 concentrates on Newfoundland and Labrador, with a tiny bit of Nunavut at the top end of the Ungava Peninsula. An inset map of St. John's, capital of Nfld/Lab is included, as is the French Overseas Territory of St. Pierre et Miquelon. The new paved highway across Labrador is the highlight of this side of the map! The second side of the map focusses on Nova Scotia/Cape Breton and parts of Prince Edward Island and New Brunswick, with a detailed inset of central Halifax. The former French fortress of Louisbourg is a must-see for anyone visiting Cape Breton, as are the many Loyalist towns created along the coast of Nova Scotia to house refugees fleeing turmoil in the American colonies during the Revolutionary War. A separate map concentrating on the Atlantic coastline of the USA is being prepared. **AVAILABLE**

Ontario Travel Reference Map 4th Ed. 2023 ISBN 9781771295949 UPC 817712959492 \$11.95cdn/us E/GBP9.95 – Ontario is another entity created by fleeing Loyalists from the American Revolution, initially called Upper Canada to separate it from French-dominated Lower Canada, or what is now Quebec. It has become the industrialized hinterland of Canada and home to eight million people, most of whom seem to congregate in the vicinity of Toronto. In area, Ontario far exceeds the size of Europe or any American state. Side 1 is dedicated to northern Ontario, a vast region of lakes and rivers, but relatively few people. The Lake of the Woods region was mapped by fur trappers and now forms a watery border between Canada and the USA. Further east, near Thunder Bay, is Old Fort William, the greatest fur fort ever made, and east of that is the Precambrian Shield, the oldest mountains on earth and source of much of the world's mineral wealth. Further east again is Cochrane, site of a polar bear sanctuary and the southern terminus of the only route to Hudson's Bay, by rail. **AVAILABLE**
