### **A WORD OF WARNING TO OUR CUSTOMERS**

### **USA DECLARES THE DUMBEST WAR IN HISTORY**

### **PHILIPPINES AS A TRAVEL DESTINATION**

Philippines, or The Philippines as most of us think of it, was a Spanish colony for centuries before being conquered by the USA in 1899 and transformed into an American overseas possession, which means a colony, the same as Cuba and Puerto Rico were. The Americans were remarkably bad at being a colonial authority, no doubt due to their own history. Cuba was soon passed off as an 'independent' country, whereby the American Fruit Company owned 97% of the land and Cubans weren't allowed any. We all know how that came to an end in 1959! Puerto Rico remains as an overseas possession to this day. Its citizens are considered to be sort-of Americans, but not allowed to vote, become a state, or decide their own future. Filipinos were rather more fortunate in a bad sort of way, in that they were seized by Japan in 1941 and occupied for most of WW2. At the end of the war, Filipinos decided that they did not want the Americans lording it over them any more and opted for independence. It declared its independence, and after some serious fighting, won the right to govern themselves, albeit by accepting that American military might was such that major US bases were allowed to stay. That eventually ended, then was re-started, and now the country is allied with the USA against China. A complicated history, indeed.

Touristically, the Philippines is quite popular. The country has 7,641 islands to explore and is the largest archipelago in the world. Although there are separatist movements on some of the islands that should be avoided, the vast majority of islands are safe, easy to get to, and friendly. Here are some Philippino facts:

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1. Many, if not most, people speak English, a legacy of association with the USA, but the national language is Filipino, with more than 170 different dialects of Tagalog. English is the second language.
2. The Philippines is the only country in Asia that is predominately Christian; 86% are Roman Catholic.
3. The largest pearl in the world was found in Palawan, one of the Philippine islands, weighing 75 pounds. It is valued at \$100 million.
4. Filipinos start celebrating Christmas in September and keeping it going until January.
5. The Philippines is the largest supplier of nurses in the world, thanks to a Canadian university establishing a training college in the country and granting degrees valid throughout North America. 25% of all nurses in the USA are Filipinos. Better not deport them!
6. Filipino men and women predominate the staff on cruise ship lines all over the world; ditto gambling casinos in Las Vegas. There are 18,000,000 Filipinos who are American citizens.
7. ITMB publishes an excellent double-side map of the country, and a separate expanded map of Luzon Island, the major and most-visited island, as well as a detailed map of Manila, the capital.

The reverse side concentrates on the entire Pyrenees mountain chain from both the French and the Spanish points of view, from Bayonne in the west to Perpignan in the east. This is less visited than Fiji, just to its west, and consists of dozens of islands and many resort hotels. The capital of Nuku'alofa is small enough to walk everywhere and is the point of embarkation for most of the other islands. Captain Cook landed on tiny Vatoa Island in 1774, and the Bounty visited volcanic Tofua Island in 1789. This is a Pacific paradise! **AVAILABLE**

The United Nations complex, the Palais des Nations, is a bit of a walk to reach, so fortunately there is a tram that goes right to the gates. The airport is shown at the top of the page. The 2<sup>nd</sup> side is a new map for us, covering the western half of Switzerland as far as Basle and Luzern, concentrating on the rail network as well as the roads. For example, it shows the rail line to Zermatt, at the base of the Matterhorn. This is a beautiful part of the world to explore! **AVAILABLE**

Then the Americans evacuated rather rapidly, the Afghan government collapsed very rapidly, and the Taliban moved in to fill the political vacuum. Ever since, the country has been difficult to enter. Regardless, a steady demand for maps of the country continues to exist. This is an important country to keep in print, but for now we have no way to accurately update it. The eastern half is the independent country of Papua New Guinea, with its capital of Port Moresby. It includes several island chains, such as the Bismark Archipelago and the Louisiade Archipelago and is closely associated with Australia, which is immediately to its south. As a result, it is somewhat developed in its infrastructure, although there is no road as yet joining the eastern portion with the central highlands, nor are there any land connections with the western half of the island. This portion is controlled by Indonesia and is known as West Irian (or Irian Jaya), with its major urban area being Sorong, in the far west, with ferry connections to Indonesian islands further to the west. The other major urban area is Jayapura, on the north coast, which also has ferry connections to other parts of Indonesia. Needless to say, the two halves of the island have little to do with each other. Both portions are definitely off-the-beaten-path destinations appealing to adventuresome travellers. **AVAILABLE**

Side 1 is a detailed map of the city surrounding the Zurichsee. The central core is centred on the busy railway station and the Limmat River that bisects the old town centre. This is now largely a pedestrian area and a tref for strolling. Ferry docks along the shoreline provide excursion day-trips as well as working ferries to transport locals to urban areas along the See. Due to its mountainous nature, the city has developed a sophisticated transit system of trams, buses, and rail connections to move people around.
